Jolly Mokorosi is a Johannesburg-based Executive Principal Officer, independent retirement fund trustee, director, and seasoned business leader with extensive experience in South Africa's financial services sector. She currently serves as Chairperson of the Sanlam Umbrella Funds, a board member of the Classic Retail Retirement Funds, and Executive Principal Officer of the SAMRO Retirement Annuity Fund. Jolly's influence in the retirement and investment industry includes her role as a non-executive director of Batseta, inaugural Deputy Chair of Batseta's Asset Owners Forum, and active member of the Southern Africa Pension Fund Investment Forum Advisory Committee. She has also contributed to shaping sustainable finance as a committee member of the National Treasury's Taxonomy for Green Finance Working Group and the Johannesburg Stock Exchange's Sustainability Advisory Committee.

Her commitment to financial inclusion and education led her to establish Wealth@Work, a platform that empowers individuals with financial literacy and tools to make informed decisions. She contributes regularly to leading financial publications and facilitates trustee training through Mokorosi Financial Consulting and ASISA's Retirement Fund Trustee Education Program. Her passion for social impact is further demonstrated by her tenure as Chair of Mother2Mothers (M2M) South Africa, a global non-profit that employs and empowers women living with HIV as community health workers. Under her leadership, M2M advanced its mission to deliver vital healthcare services to families, fostering healthier communities across the continent.

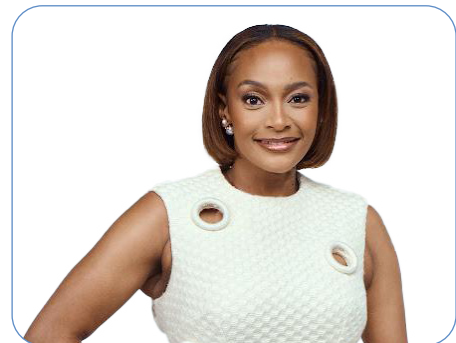
In April 2025, Jolly made history as the first woman appointed Chairperson of the Sanlam Umbrella Fund, reinforcing the fund's and Sanlam Corporate's commitment to transformation and forward-thinking leadership. She succeeded David Gluckman, under whose guidance the fund grew its Assets Under Management by R80 billion during the pandemic, reaching over R125 billion. With her deep experience from roles in retirement funds and industry forums, Jolly is well positioned to continue driving value, inclusivity, and strong governance. Trustees and peers have praised her fairness, strategic mindset, and willingness to challenge the status quo in pursuit of improved outcomes for fund members.
